Donations to goPINK help cover the costs of integrative medicine therapy for all cancer survivors served by Middlesex Health Cancer Center, including those with breast cancer. Integrative medicine complements conventional cancer treatment. It focuses on the whole person – mind, body and spirit, and can help many patients find relief from pain, neuropathy and other cancer-related symptoms.

Our generous community has donated more than \$395,000 to goPINK since 2010, which has helped more than 2,100 cancer patients receive free integrative medicine therapy. Founded in 2010 by EG Salon in Middletown, Connecticut, the project has grown to include participating salons, businesses and schools throughout Middlesex County.




