

Fluoride Testing Instructions

Your child needs fluoride for continued good oral health. Most cities and towns will add fluoride to the public water supply. If you have well water, your child may not be receiving the fluoride they need to protect their teeth now and in the future.

Your doctor has recommended that you have your well water tested. Some wells do contain a small amount of fluoride. If your water has no fluoride or a small amount, your doctor can give you a prescription for a supplement that your child can take once per day. Some wells contain too much fluoride, which can lead to permanent staining of the teeth. This would also be important for you and your doctor to know.
